In addition, Enel Americas received the Industry Mover Award, a distinction given to companies that have made the greatest proportional advances in their performance in sustainability as compared to the previous year.

This year, The Sustainability Yearbook awarded 236 medals to those companies that achieved the best sustainability performance compared to their peers in their respective categories

Enel Américas - a subsidiary of the Enel Group - is one of the main private electric multinationals in Latin America. Currently, it has direct and indirect participation in the electricity generation, transmission, and distribution businesses and related areas. It has operations in four countries in the region: Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, and Peru.
